<b>Settlement Date:</b>	We expect that delivery of the notes will be made against payment therefor on or about March 3, 2008, which will be the 5th business day following the date of pricing of the Global Notes (such settlement cycle being herein referred to as "T + 5"). Under Rule 15c6-1 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, as amended, trades in the secondary market generally are required to settle in three business days, unless the parties to any such trade expressly agree otherwise. Accordingly, purchasers who wish to trade Global Notes on the date of pricing or the next succeeding business day will be required, by virtue of the fact that the Global Notes initially will settle T + 5, to specify an alternate settlement cycle at the time of any such trade to prevent a failed settlement.
