(1) 12/10/08 NQ Grant: The options will vest in equal increments over four years measured from the date of grant as follows: 1/4 shall vest on 12/10/09; 1/4 shall vest on 12/10/10; 1/4 shall vest on 12/10/11; and 1/4 shall vest on 12/10/12.

(2) 12/11/08 NQ Grant: The options will vest in equal increments over five years measured from the date of grant as follows: 1/5 shall vest on 12/11/09; 1/5 shall vest on 12/11/10; 1/5 shall vest on 12/11/11; 1/5 shall vest on 12/11/12; and 1/5 shall vest on 12/11/13.

(3) Grant Date 10/30/08 NQ Date Exer.: One-fourth shall vest on the earlier of (a) 10/30/09 or (b) when the average closing price reaches \$17.73; one-fourth shall vest on the earlier of (a) 10/30/10 or (b) when the average closing price reaches \$19.00; one-fourth shall vest on the earlier of (a) 10/30/11 or (b) when the average closing price reaches \$20.58; one-fourth shall vest on the earlier of (a) 10/30/12 or (b) when the average closing price reaches \$22.16.

(4) Sale price represents an average of the selling prices between \$39.75 and \$39.84.
