Effective May 29, 2008, Scott Greenberg resigned from the Board of Directors of GSE Systems, Inc. (the “Company”) to pursue personal interests. During Mr. Greenberg’s tenure with the Company, the Company and Mr. Greenberg had no disagreements relating to the Company’s operations, policies or practices.

On May 29, 2008, the Board of Directors of the Company elected Jane Bryant Quinn as a Director, replacing Mr. Greenberg. Ms. Quinn is an “independent” director as defined under Section 803 of The American Stock Exchange Company Guide. Ms. Quinn is one of the nation’s leading experts on personal finance. She currently writes a monthly column for Newsweek magazine and a biweekly column for Bloomberg.com and has authored several books on personal finance.

Ms. Quinn has many awards to her credit, including an Emmy Award for outstanding coverage of news on television and the Gerald Loeb award for distinguished lifetime achievement in business and financial journalism. She has been named by the World Almanac as one of the 25 most influential women in the United States.

She served on the boards of the Harvard School of Public Health, the Jerome Levy Economics Institute of Bard College, and her alma mater, Middlebury College. She is currently a director of Bloomberg L.P., the financial services company.
